was created by the vote of the landowners on August 27, 1947 in accordance with the provisions of the Indiana Soil Conservation Act of 1937. Our purpose is to provide information about soil, water, and related natural resource conservation; identify and prioritize local soil and water resource concerns; and connect land users to sources of educational, technical and financial assistance to implement conservation practices and technologies.

The Wayne County Soil & Water Conservation District is governed by a five-member board of supervisors who work directly with the community on conservation concerns. They identify local soil, water and related natural resource concerns, set natural resource priorities, and then develop, implement and evaluate long and short range plans and programs to address these prioritized resource concerns.
